# **GROUND PACKAGE GUIDELINES**

- a. Each trip is for two (2) people: one (1) winner and one (1) guest. **NO EXCEPTIONS;**
- b. At least one (1) Trip Participant must be twenty-one (21) years of age or older at the time of the trip. Minimum age for 2nd Participant is thirteen (13) years of age;
- c. A parent, grandparent, brother, sister or legal guardian must accompany any Trip Participant under eighteen (18) years of age;
- d. A legal guardian traveling with a minor must provide both the Sponsoring Station and Haas Entertainment with a certified copy of the court ordered guardianship documents by Friday, October 20<sup>th</sup>. No fax or photocopies can be accepted;
- e. No parent, grandparent, brother, sister or legal guardian may leave any minor alone (or in the care of anyone else) at any time, event, venue or in the hotel;
- f. It is illegal for any Trip Participant under twenty-one (21) years of age to consume alcohol;
- g. It is illegal for any Trip Participant to purchase, enable, facilitate or provide alcohol to anyone under twenty-one (21) years of age;
- h. J.D. Haas Entertainment cannot transport anyone under twenty-one (21) years of age who is intoxicated;
- i. Possession of and / or consumption of alcoholic beverages is not permitted on any ground transportation vehicle;
- j. Trip Participants may be required to be at least twenty-one (21) years of age or older to be admitted to Honky Tonks and/or nightclubs;
- k. No Trip Participant shall be allowed to use trip ground transportation vehicles other than as a passenger;
- l. No Trip Participant shall be allowed to stay in any ground transportation vehicle alone while the group is attending an event or activity;
- m. The Trip must be taken from Tuesday, November 7<sup>th</sup> through Thursday, November 9<sup>th</sup>. Trips not taken during and between these dates are subject to forfeiture without rescheduling;
- n. Lodging accommodations to include only room base rate and applicable state & local taxes;
- o. The Hotel Preston is a Smoke Free Facility. No Smoking is allowed in Common Areas, Guest Rooms, Courtyards, Pool, Public Areas or Restaurants.
- p. There is a \$500.00 cleaning charge for smoking in a non-smoking room;
- q. Trip Participants are responsible for a refundable \$100.00 hotel deposit (cash or credit card) applicable to any hotel services desired (i.e. internet, telephone, in-room movies, room service, restaurant charges, etc.) other than those included in the trip;

- r. Trip participants are responsible for all of their meals, beverages, tips and spending cash;
- s. Scheduled trip events are **OPTIONAL**. Attendance at scheduled events is **NOT MANDATORY**;
- t. All restaurants listed are **SUGGESTIONS** - Attendance at scheduled meals is **NOT MANDATORY**;
- u. Any Trip Participant choosing not to participate in scheduled events shall be solely responsible for securing of and payment for their own transportation, admission, and other fees and expenses at the unscheduled event of their choosing;
- v. Admission tickets are distributed prior to each event and only the primary Trip Winner may receive the tickets;
- w. Once distributed, misplaced, lost or stolen tickets to any scheduled event cannot be replaced;
- x. Event admission tickets, lodging accommodations, ground transportation and laminates & lanyards are not transferable;
- y. Each Trip Participant must possess two (2) valid forms of personal identification, including one (1) picture I.D.;
- z. Due to the many physical activities encompassed by trip events, Trip Participants must be in at least such general good health as to be able to participate in scheduled trip events;
- aa. During the course of the trip, if any event is canceled or postponed by any occurrence not occasioned by the conduct of Haas Entertainment and / or Sponsoring Record Label whether such occurrence be by act of God or the result of war, riot, sovereign conduct, or the act or conduct of any person or entity not party to the trip, then Haas Entertainment and Sponsoring Record Label shall be excused from any and all obligations pertaining to the canceled or postponed trip event;
- bb. This trip is rated **G** for General Audiences. Disorderly behavior and / or illegal conduct may result in revocation of trip winner and their guests' hotel accommodations, ground transportation, event tickets and participation in scheduled trip events;
- cc. Each Trip Participant must individually execute a release & waiver forms (Section 5 of the Trip Winner Kit) before commencing on the trip, releasing Haas Entertainment, Sponsoring Record Label and their owners, employees, trip personnel, representatives, agents, directors, officers, successors and / or assigns from any and all claims or liability including but not limited to such liability arising from any acts or omissions resulting in injury to body or property of contest winners while they are participating in the trip including while in transit to and from Nashville;
- dd. Haas Entertainment must be in possession of completed, original copies of Trip Winner and Guest's Forms (Section 5 of the Trip Winner Kit) before Trip Participants can check into the trip;
- ee. By their participation in this promotion all Trip Participants automatically authorize Haas Entertainment and Sponsoring Record

Label use and / or other exploitation (including promotional and/or commercial) of each and every Trip Participant's name, image, voice and / or likeness in audio, video, website, print and/or other media;

- ff. All events, dates, venues, trip staff and ground package guidelines are subject to change.

# **AIRFARE PACKAGE GUIDELINES**

- a. Haas Entertainment or Sponsoring Record Label will reserve, book and secure roundtrip coach class airline transportation for the Trip Winner and their Guest;
- b. Trip Winners and/or Station may be responsible for completing mandatory Record Label Promotional Support Information and to fax or email it to Haas Entertainment before flights can be booked;
- c. FINAL Trip Winner AND Guest Names, Date of Birth and Gender must be provided to Haas Entertainment Friday, October 20<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 AM Central Standard Time in order to guarantee Sponsoring Record Label a two-week advance airfare purchase (It usually takes several days for a Trip Winner to secure a Guest and confirm flight options researched for them);
- d. Trip Participants are responsible for transportation to and from the airport they will be flying out of and back in to and if applicable any airport parking fees;
- e. Trip Participants will be flown into and out of Nashville International Airport;
- f. Trip Participants may be required to fly out of and back into the closest MAJOR market airport to the city of the their Sponsoring Station;
- g. If Trip Participants airline tickets are booked on the open market, then roundtrip coach class airfare will include base fare, taxes, passenger facility charges and security fees;
- h. Trip Participants are responsible for any baggage charges. Most airlines now charge \$25.00 to check one (1) piece of luggage and \$35.00 for a second (2) piece of luggage – each way;
- i. Flights into Nashville will be ticketed for travel on Tuesday, November 7<sup>th</sup> and will be scheduled to arrive between the hours of 9:00 AM and 5:00 PM;
- j. Flights out of Nashville will be ticketed for travel on Thursday, November 9<sup>th</sup> and will be scheduled to depart between the hours of 6:00 AM and 8:00 PM;
- k. Once Trip Participants airline tickets are purchased the passenger names cannot be changed;
- l. Airline Tickets are not transferable;
- m. Trip Participants are required to fly on the same flights together. If any Trip Participant wishes to fly out of or back at a different time or date or

from a different city, then the Trip Participant is responsible for any difference in airfare;

- n. Trip Participants are required to fly on the flights that have been pre-reserved for their Sponsoring Station. If any Trip Participant wants a change in airlines, flight times and / or connecting city, then the Trip Participant is responsible for any difference in airfare;
- o. If a Trip Winner is pregnant, travel within 4 weeks of the delivery date or within 7 days after delivery requires a medical certificate as well as clearance from the airline's special assistance coordinator;
- p. Airline Electronic Tickets will be emailed directly to the trip winner;
- q. Trip Participants are responsible for calling the airline they will be traveling on to book their seat assignments, provide a telephone contact number and, if applicable, find out baggage charges and arrange for any special needs;
- r. If an Airline delay or cancellation occurs due to circumstances beyond an airlines control (i.e. weather, air traffic control etc.) and passengers cannot make it to their destination on the day scheduled, most airlines policies state that it is up to the passengers to pay for any additional costs including but not limited to hotel accommodations, ground transportation and / or meal costs in the city the passengers are delayed in. Passengers should ask an airline agent for discount coupons;
- s. If an Airline delay or cancellation occurs due to circumstances within an Airlines control (i.e. aircraft swaps, crew delays, etc.) and the passengers cannot make it to their destination on the day scheduled, most airlines policies state that the Airline usually will pay for any additional costs including but not limited to hotel accommodations, ground transportation and / or meal costs in the city the passengers are delayed in. Passengers should ask an airline agent for details;
- t. Individual Airline Rules will be included on each passengers Electronic Ticket;
- u. Individual Airline terms, conditions and restrictions also apply to airfare guidelines;
- v. If the primary Trip Winner lives within 350 miles of Nashville then airline transportation may not be included;
- w. Airfare package guidelines are subject to change.

## **TRIP WINNER TAX GUIDELINES**

### **IRS TAX OBLIGATIONS**

The primary trip winner needs to understand their IRS tax responsibilities AND obligations that go along with the acceptance of this prize.

Please consult an accountant or call the IRS if you have any tax questions in regards to the requirements that go along with this prize.

### **IRS DEFINITION OF TRIP WINNER'S TAX LIABILITY**

If a person wins a prize by a lucky number drawing, television or radio quiz program, beauty contest or other event, they must include it in their income.

For example, if a person wins a \$50 prize in a photography contest, they must report this income on form 1040.

If a person refuses to accept a prize, they do not include its value in their income.

Prizes and awards in goods or services must be included in their income at their "Fair Market Value."

(800) 829-4933 is a direct line to the Internal Revenue Service Specialty Tax Department.

### **IRS DEFINITION OF "FAIR MARKET VALUE"**

What a willing seller can get from a willing buyer with no pressure to buy or sell by either party and with both parties knowing all the facts and circumstances.

### **TRIP WINNER'S GUEST TAX LIABILITY**

If a Trip Winner takes a guest on a trip they have won, only the trip winner is responsible for taxes. The only exception is if a prize is awarded in two names.

### **ESTIMATED FAIR MARKET VALUE**

The ESTIMATED "Fair Market Value" of the "Dream Trip of a Lifetime" to Music City U.S.A. Ground Package AND Airfare Package is \$3,500

### **TAX RETURN RESPONSIBILITIES**

Even if a Trip Winner does not receive a 1099 form from their Sponsoring Station, the Trip Winner is still obligated to declare the Ground Package AND Airfare Package prize "Fair Market Value" as income on their 2017 tax return.

General Contest Rules for Renda Broadcasting Jacksonville

#### **General Conditions:**

1. Station expressly disclaims all responsibility for all property loss, property damage, bodily injury

and death resulting, directly or indirectly, from any contest prize excluding damages, loss, injury

or death caused by willful misconduct or gross negligence of station.



2. Station expressly disclaims all responsibility and liability for loss, inconvenience and other

damage you may suffer resulting from the postponements, modifications or cancellation of any

contest or promotions due to technical difficulties or Acts of God.

3. You shall be responsible for all federal, state and local taxes that may arise by reason of your

receipt or use of the contest prize.

4. This offer is VOID if you reside in a jurisdiction that prohibits promotions or contest of this kind.

5. Your federal, state or local government may impose additional conditions on your acceptance of

this prize.

6. By accepting your prizes, you affirm that you are neither a co-sponsor nor employee of any radio

or television station and each of their respective parent, affiliate, and subsidiary companies, and

advertising or promotional agencies.

7. By accepting your prizes, you affirm that you are neither an employee of Renda Broadcasting

Stations nor a member of the immediate family of any employee of the station.

8. You agree to allow the station to use your name, voice and likeness on the air and in any publicity

information.

9. Your prize may carry a deadline and or certain restrictions based on age, availability and calendar

restrictions.

10. The radio station will hold your prize for a period of 30 days from the date it was awarded. After

that period of time, the prize reverts to the station and will be dealt with at the sole discretion of

the station management.

11. All participants of on-site giveaways must be present to claim their prize. The station shall not and

will not be held responsible for non-attendance of participant at the time of drawing. It is the sole

responsibility of the participant to be present.

12. Winners of any regularly scheduled Monday-Friday contest and members of their households are

ineligible to win any other weekday contest for a period of 30 days, with the expressed exceptions

listed below:

- Winners of consolation prizes are eligible to participate in all contests and are excluded

from the 30-day waiting period.

- Winners of special Radio Station promotions, scheduled periodically throughout the year,

are eligible to play other contest regardless of the amount of time since winning their last

prize from the station – excluding major prize winners. These special promotions may not

be identified on or off air.

- Winners of major prizes, given away wholly or in part by the radio station, are excluded
